Library eBooks & Audiobooks

Android, Apple, & Nook

Installing the App:

- Search for **Libby, by OverDrive** in your app store (*Android/Nook: Google Play, Apple: App Store*) and install the app.

Add Our Library:

- On the welcome screen, Libby will ask if you have a library card. Hit **Yes**.
- Search for the library.
 - a) **Copy From My Other Device** - on the old device (if you previously used Libby), go to Menu > Settings > Copy to Another Device and **enter the code on the new device**.
 - b) **I'll Search for a Library** - enter our zip code: **11751**.
 - c) **Yes, Use My Location** - Libby will use your location to find your library.
- Select **Sign in with my card**, then select **LiveLibrary.com Islip Public Library**.
- Tap on **Islip Public Library** to add your library card by selecting **barcode and library card password**. Tap **Next** to save your card information.

Navigating Libby:



- To search for titles and authors, tap the **magnify glass** at the bottom of your screen.



- To browse by subjects, just added titles, & featured collections, tap the **library icon**.



- The **Libby icon** will bring up the menu. You can access your library card, help & support, settings and more. Tap **HIDE** to close the menu in the upper right corner.



- To read & manage your loans & holds, tap the **book icon** to see your shelf. See how many days remain on your loans and view tags (if you apply any).



- To view your reading history, tap the **clock icon**. Tap the **actions** button to enable/disable this feature.

- A book cover with an **image of earbuds** underneath it, indicates the format is an audiobook.

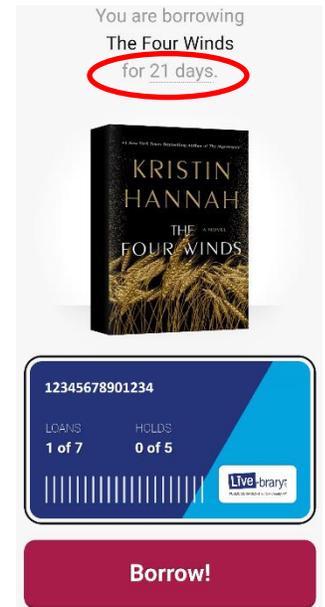
Contact the Library to book a librarian for a one-on-one 30-minute session.

- The book is immediately available when it says **Borrow** by the book cover.
- You have to go on the waitlist when it says **Place Hold** by the book cover. Tap on the **blue calendar icon** to see current wait times.
- To get more details and a description of the book, tap the **book cover**.



Borrowing and Downloading Books:

- Tap **Borrow** to check out the book.
- Above the book cover, you'll see the lending period. **Tap on the number of days** to adjust the lending period.
- You will see your digital library card displaying your loan & hold limits.
- Tap on **Borrow** to confirm your check out. The book will begin to download.
- Now, you can **open the book** or **go to your shelf**.



Renew/Return Books:

- You can renew books within 72 hours before it's due, if there are no holds on the book. Go to your **shelf** and tap on **Manage Loan** to renew.
- You can return books early. Go to your **shelf** and tap on **Manage Loan** to return.
