Accessing Libby:

Open your browser & go to libbyapp.com on your Kindle Fire or another device.

Add Our Library:

- On the welcome screen, Libby will guide you to your digital library.
- Tap Yes to add your card and choose an option:
 - a) Copy From My Other Device on the old device (if you previously used Libby), go to Menu > Settings > Copy to Another Device and enter the code on the new device.
 - b) I'll Search for a Library enter our zip code: 11751.
 - c) Yes, Use My Location Libby will use your location to find your library.
- For options b & c above, tap on Livebrary.com Islip Public Library.
- Tap on Islip Public Library to add your library card by entering your barcode and library card password. Tap Next to save your card information.

Navigating Libby:



To search for titles and authors, tap the magnify glass at the bottom of your screen.



To browse by subjects, just added titles, & featured collections, tap the library icon.



• The Libby icon will bring up the menu. You can access your library card, help & support, settings and more. Tap HIDE to close the menu in the upper right corner.



To read & manage your loans & holds, tap the book icon to see your shelf. See how
many days remain on your loans and view tags (if you apply any).

• To view your reading history, tap the **clock icon**. Tap the **actions** button to enable/disable this feature.

- The book is immediately available when it says Borrow by the book cover.
- You have to go on the waitlist when it says Place Hold by the book cover. Tap on the blue calendar icon to see current wait times.
- To get more details and a description of the book, tap the book cover.









Borrowing and Downloading Books:

- Tap Borrow to check out the book.
- Above the book cover, you'll see the lending period. Tap on the number of days to adjust the lending period.
- You will see your digital library card displaying your loan & hold limits.
- Tap on Borrow to confirm your check out.
- Tap go to your shelf, tap Read With..., tap Kindle.
 - Sign in to your Amazon account.
 - Make sure the 'deliver to' option is set to your kindle device and tap Get Library Book. The book will be downloaded to your Kindle Library (internet connection required).





NOTE: Not all books are available in Kindle format. You can still read the book in your browser; an internet connection is required.

Renew/Return Books:

- You can renew books within 72 hours before it's due on libbyapp.com, if there are no holds on the book. Go to your Shelf, tap on Manage Loan to renew. You may need to re-download the book once the renewal comes into effect.
- Kindle users can return books through Amazon.com. Go to Your Account > Content & Devices > Return This Book.
